Meet Nati, 2012. He is 29 years old. He graduated from the Israeli army as a captain, and is an excellent sportsman and musician. He is in his second year of university studying economics and management, and works as a personal trainer. In his spare time, he volunteers in one of Orr Shalom's home as a 'big brother'. Nati is extremely confident, and contributes greatly to Israeli society.

Orr Shalom does not give up on any child...please help give these children a second chance

- It costs £20 per day to rescue and care for each Orr Shalom child.
- £50 a month funds after-school tutors for one child, to help them with their academic studies and learning difficulties, and build their self-confidence.
- £150 funds a start-up kit for one new child in our care. Many of our children are removed from their homes in an emergency situation and arrive with no personal possessions; some with just the clothes on their backs. The start-up kits provide essential, practical resources to children in immediate distress.
- £300 funds one child's clothing and shoes for one year.
- £450 funds after-school enrichment, such as art, dance, sport and music activities, for one child for one year.
- £950 funds one child's bar or bat mitzvah which involves a meaningful ceremony in a local synagogue or place of their choice, followed by a celebration in a restaurant, function hall, or at home.
- £1500 funds therapeutic services for one child for one year, which includes weekly individual sessions with Orr Shalom psychologists or social workers.
- £2200 funds one child to attend Orr Shalom's four therapeutic camps each year, when their group homes are closed during vacation times. These children are orphans or would face definite abuse if they returned home for even a short period.
